Discharge Instructions

DATE: January 29, 2016

CLIENT NAME: Mrs. Nancy Denny

PATIENT NAME: Layla

FINAL DIAGNOSIS: Today's echocardiogram revealed that Layla has normal atrial and ventricular dimensions (LA: 2.35cm, LVEDD: 4.39cm), normal myocardial contractility (SF: 30%, EF=58%) and normal intra-cardiac blood flow. There is no evidence of underlying heart disease or dilated cardiomyopathy at this time. Layla appears to be heart healthy. I would suggest continuing to intermittently Holter monitor Layla to ensure that she remains normal. Weight=75 lbs.

TREATMENT: No treatment is currently recommended.

FEEDING: Normal diet.

EXERCISE: No restrictions.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS: Because cardiomyopathy is an adult onset disease, Layla will require life-long monitoring.
